'ECC The chemical distribution sector

- The Chemical distribution industry in Europe employs more than 30,000 people and has an annual sales leverage of approximately €28 billion
- Direct sales (still) dominate the chemical industry*
- Chemical distribution sector has growth premium over underlying chemical market and GDP across regions*
- Specialty chemical distribution with strong growth of ~ 5% p.a.*
- Going forward, specialty chemical distribution market is expected to continue growing at ~ 5% p.a., again outgrowing the underlying specialty chemical market*
